

## **Program**

Tonight's Program was a tag-team event by Garden Grove City Councilman Bruce Broadwater and the Greg's (Greg Brown - Redevelopment Manager and Greg Blodgett - Senior Project Manager from the City's Eco**nomic Development** department). They talked to the **Club** about the efforts to bring a major water park hotel to the Harbor Blvd area of Garden Grove. The City has approved the McWhinney/Stonebridge group to develop a water park hotel on ten acres of land that used to be the old Firestation Motel. It will consist of 600 rooms, approximately 15,000 square feet of retail/restaurants, and a parking structure. It will also contain up to 3 acres of indoor and outdoor water park areas. The City studied several water park hotel areas, including sites in Florida and the Wisconsin Dells area, to get ideas and concepts of what they wanted to see in Garden Grove. The proposed water park hotel is projected to bring in \$4M in annual bed tax that will add to the already \$13M annual bed tax that Garden Grove now collects from the Harbor Blvd area hotels. Planning and project development are ongoing and current plans call for a July 2014 start date.
