Tonight's Program was **Zoot Velasco**, Executive Director of the **Muckenthaler Cultural Center** in **Fullerton**. Yes, that is his real name! He was previously a dancer and performer and did a lot of routines in a zoot suit. **Zoot** was at first a nickname, but he had his name legally changed in 1986. The **Muckenthaler Cultural Center** is the former estate of **Walter** and **Adella Muckenthaler** of **Fullerton**. The 18-room villa sits on 8.5 acres top of a hill in **Fullerton** and was built in 1924. The house and land was donated to the city in 1965 by **Harold Muckenthaler**. He wanted to see his childhood home used as a cultural center for the public to enjoy. In 1999, the **Muckenthaler Cultural Center** was designated a Historical Landmark by the National Register of Historic Places. **Zoot** tells us the Center is used for extraordinary exhibitions, performances and educational programs for the **Orange County** community.
